TARCOG and ALDOT are seeking **STRONG** citizen participation.

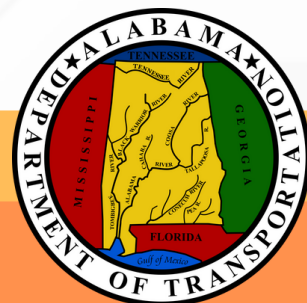

ABOUT THE STIP 2024

The State Transportation Improvement Plan (STIP) is a document that assesses the State's transportation system and presents plans for improvement and maintenance.

Updated every 4 years, it details how Federal and State money will be spent on transportation projects such as road expansion, bridges, transit, and more.

Projects are developed in coordination with the state's metropolitan planning and rural planning organizations.

The 2020 STIP was the previously plan and will be updated next year. The Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) develops the STIP in accordance with the Fixing America's Surface Transportation Act (FAST Act) and applicable federal regulations.

TARCOG hosts the Rural Planning Organization (RPO) for our region.

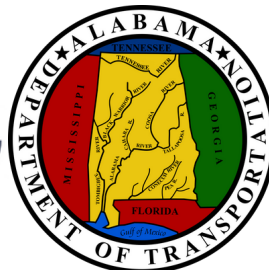
PUBLIC PARTICIPATION
