Serving People: TARCOG Receives Workforce Inclusion Grant

TARCOG has been awarded a grant of nearly \$584,000 from the Center for Workforce Inclusion, Inc. (the Center) to provide temporary employment to low-income older adults throughout our region.

Our team will be delivering career training programs under the Senior Community Service Employment Program (SCSEP). The SCSEP is the only federal job training program targeted exclusively to low-income older jobseekers.

"SCSEP helps our community's eligible 55+ jobseekers learn new skills and refresh old ones when they are coming back into the workforce," said Michelle Jordan, Executive Director of TARCOG.
